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The Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) will reconstruct Tasha Drive from Flamingo Drive to Northwood Street to meet current MOA design criteria for a local roadway (see map for the project limits on the reverse). Improvements will include new road foundation, new storm drain with footing drain services, new lighting, new curb & gutter, new asphalt pavement, and utility relocations.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE & DETAILS

MOA Project Management & Engineering Department (PM&E) is preparing to begin construction of the Tasha Drive Reconstruction Project. See the map below for the project limits.

Demolition work and gas relocation work (by ENSTAR Natural Gas Company) is anticipated to begin in early August 2026 followed by the storm drain installation and roadway reconstruction work.

MOA will be represented by an on-site inspector during construction to ensure the quality of work and minimize inconveniences. The inspector will work with residents to try and accommodate any special property access needs. MOA selected Southcentral Construction, Inc. (Southcentral) to perform the construction of this project through the public bidding process. MOA and Southcentral contact information is provided on the reverse side. For the Contractor to complete the work and avoid damage to private improvements, please remove private improvements from the MOA right-of-way (ROW) including motor homes or trailers that extend into the MOA ROW. Both vehicular and pedestrian traffic along Tasha Drive will be impacted throughout the duration of the project.

Delays will be kept to a minimum, but drivers should anticipate detours and other temporary adjustments to the traffic pattern. Please obey all traffic control signage and personnel. If you have questions, please don't hesitate to contact a member of the project team listed on the reverse side.



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
